Half-Day Tours

Choose from three available half-day tours. All tours are fully guided and include all transportation and admissions.

Tour #1

Lift Lock & River Boat Cruise and Lang Pioneer Village

Take a cruise through the World's Largest Hydraulic Lift Lock located on the Trent-Severn Waterway and marvel at this incredible feat of engineering. After your cruise, travel back in time at Lang Pioneer Village while you explore the restored 19th century buildings including an operational Grist Mill. Villagers of all ages recreate a typical day with demonstrations including blacksmithing, carpentry, rug hooking, spinning, weaving and printmaking.

Tour #2

Whetung Ojibwa Centre and Stony Lake Cruise

Experience the traditions of the past reflected in the present at the Whetung Ojibwa Centre located in the heart of the Curve Lake Indian Reserve. The centre offers a spectacular collection of Indian crafts, fine art, sculpture, masks, leatherwork, clothing, jewelry, music, and books. Then travel on a 140-passenger steamboat replica for a 2-hour cruise through the 1,128 charted islands of Stony and Clear Lakes.



Tour #3

Canadian Canoe Museum and Sightseeing Tour of Peterborough

Visit North America's only canoe museum with over 600 canoes and kayaks. Follow the history of Canada and our Heritage Sightseeing tour, which includes a tour through the Lift Lock tunnel, a visit to the tourist centre, a trip to the Peterborough Museum and Archives where you can learn about the city's past, and to finish, a trip to the Riverview Zoo.

Additional Tours

In addition to the three half-day tours, consider an evening walking tour or take a day trip to Toronto.

Evening Walk #1

Ghost Walk in Eerie Ashburnham

Walk through Ashburnham, a village founded in 1859 and annexed to the city of Peterborough in 1904. Locals still refer to the eastern shore of the Otonabee River as “East City”. Ashburnham is full of stately old residences that are rumoured to be still occupied by some of the village’s original settlers.

Evening Walk #2

Scandals and Scoundrels, Historic Pub Crawl

Peterborough’s downtown core is unique as many of the original hotels and taverns are still standing, leaving local history largely visible. Your guide will take you through four historic taverns, and naturally being a pub-crawl, you will have time to stop for a drink!

Toronto Full Day Tour

Take the opportunity to visit Ontario’s capital city. This full day tour includes a visit to the world famous CN Tower, a 3-hour City Tour on a luxury motor coach with an expert Torontonion Guide, and a view of the Toronto Skyline on a one-hour Mariposa Harbour Cruise around the Harbour and Toronto Islands.
